Dr. Bernice Dahn is the Minister of Health in the Republic of Liberia, heading the country's Ministry of Health and Social Welfare. Dr. Dahn previously held positions as Reproductive Health Adviser at United Nations Population Fund for four years, Family Health Director at the Liberia Ministry of Health for three years and a year as the Director for Nutrition at the Liberia Ministry of Health.

Dr. Dahn received a Certificate of Competence from Regional Training of Trainers for Reproductive Health at Mauritius Institute of Health in Pamplemousses, Mauritius; followed by a Certificate on International Health from the School of Public Health & Community Medicine at University of Washington, and a Certificate on Health Management from the International Health Exchange and Cooperation Center at the Ministry of Health, Beijing in the People's Republic of China.
