Dr. Bethany Hedt-Gauthier earned her PhD in Biostatistics from Harvard School of Public Health and is currently an Assistant Professor in the Department of Global Health and Social Medicine at Harvard Medical School. Her research interests include developing methods to support program monitoring and evaluation or disease surveillance that are informative without unnecessarily draining resources.

In addition to methodology development, Dr. Hedt-Gauthier collaborates on operations research projects related to clinical outcomes of patients. Her current work spans a variety of topics, including HIV, TB, malaria, electronic health systems, data quality assessments, and community health workers in Malawi, Tanzania, Rwanda and Lesotho. Dr. Hedt-Gauthier teaches a course on Quantitative Methods for Monitoring and Evaluation at HSPH and leads several 1-4 day courses on the topic every year.
